2. The online application form will be available at the following link <https://forms.office.com/r/8MavRHE3A2> until **noon (CET) of Friday, 11th June 2021**. However, this expression of interest will reopen as follows:
 - Opening date: 12:01 pm of Friday 11th June 2021 and Closing date: 12:00 noon on Friday, 18th June 2021
 - Opening date: 12:01 pm of Friday, 18th June 2021 and Closing date: 12:00 noon on Friday, 25th June 2021
 - Opening date: 12:01 pm of Friday 25th June 2021 and Closing date: 12:00 noon on Friday, 2nd July 2021
3. When filling in the form, please ensure you are logged in to your own ilearn account since your identity will be captured automatically. After submitting the form, you will receive a confirmation email.
4. Selection will be by seniority within each of the periods specified at paragraph 2 above. In cases where a seniority number is not available (e.g. supply teachers), teaching experience will be taken into consideration.
5. An all-inclusive remuneration of €17.10 for each 40-minute lesson will be given, covering the lessons as well as and any required preparation.





6. Lessons will be delivered in person at selected regional centres as listed in the online form as well as virtually or a simultaneous combination of both.
7. In-Person lessons will be held in 4 centres (3 in Malta and 1 in Gozo) between Monday and Thursday and will run between 08:30 and 12:30.
8. Whilst students attending these classes will require individualised support, teachers will be provided with information regarding the topics to be prioritised.
9. Selected teachers will be required to attend an information session via Teams in preparation for the programme.
